- The benefit of this type of writing is to teach children how to use words to describe an idea. The main goal is to help children to feel comfortable and confident about writing.

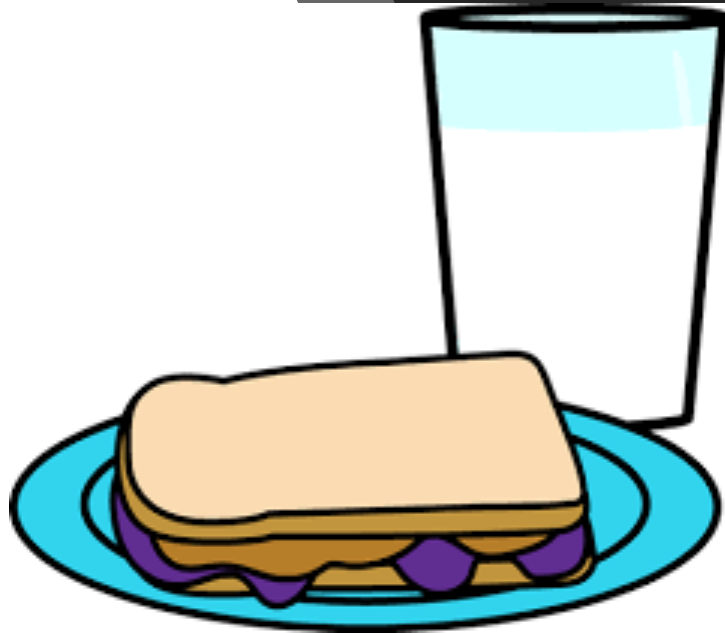

Ingredients We Need



- Children will be encouraged to make the list of ingredients they need.
- Since this is an interactive writing activity, parents are encouraged to write some words with their child.
- Children will be encouraged to sound out the words.
- List of Ingredients:
- 2 slices of Bread
- Peanut Butter
- Jelly
- A knife
- A plate

The Recipe



- Children will write the steps of how to make peanut butter and jelly sandwich.
- They will be asked to write the steps using simple words. Parents will write the words that the child can't sound out and spell.
- First, I will spread peanut butter on a slice of bread.
- Then, I will spread jelly on the other slice of bread.
- Last, I put the two slices of the bread together.
- Sandwich is ready!
