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Instructions:

- ❖ I will show you how you can make your word family house.
- ❖ Take a construction paper and make a house cutout. Write -at as a heading and draw 4- 6 windows and give one or two examples of -at words.
- ❖ Write b+at=bat, c+at+=cat. Then let your child write in the other windows.
- ❖ To make this activity challenging ask your child to write a sentence with each word. Repeat this activity with other word families for example: -am, -ad - in, -it, -ot, -op
